Dear Comrade,

Sub; Unprecedented heavy drain and flood in Kerala-reg.

As you are aware that, the heavy rains in Kerala for the past few days has caused serious damages. So far around forty three people have lost their lives, thousands including BSNL employees have lost their homes. Thousands of people have shifted to relief camps. The climate is likely to continue for about 5 or 6 days more as per the forecast, which further aggravate the situation.

It is also intimated that so many exchanges/ offices are badly affected by the flood. Due to power interruption certain areas the BTSs also getting down. Some exchanges are running in diesel due to the interruption of electricity. We are spending huge amount for this. No sufficient fund is allotted for diesel from Corporate office. So we request you to take up the issue with corporate office and request them to take helping hand to Kerala circle by allotting adequate fund to overcome the situation.

**Labour Commissioner Office March Postponed:** Due to the heavy and flood in Kerala we are not able to conduct Labour Commissioner Office March on 13.8.2019. So BSNLEU and BSNLCCWF jointly decided to postpone the march. It will be conducted after the flood.
