Sub:- Poor service due to shortage of staff - req

Complaints are being received from various corners of the circle regarding the poor service of BSNL especially in the Land line and mobile sector. As you are aware that a good number of staff in the cadre of TM and Sr.TOA got retired during these period and service is being maintained by the contract labours. It is understood that order has been issued to terminate the contract workers to extent of 20% from 1st June 2019. But in Trivandrum it was from 1st May 2019. The provisions of Industrial Dispute Act have been completely violated by the Trivandrum SSA administration. Sir, your good self has given some assurances during the discussion on 19.02.2019 in which myself had also attended. But the administration has gone back from the assurances and instruction issued to the SSAs for termination. The termination of the labourers at this stage will adversely affect our services and there by our services will be declined. As you are aware even in Kerala BSNL is struggling hard to move ahead under the stiff competition put forward by Reliance Jio, any protest from the workers will have negative impact on our service as well as revenue. Therefore we request you to kindly instruct the BAs to keep the order in abeyance.
