Sub: - **Submitting items for discussion in the 10th meeting of the Sports and Cultural Board – req.**


With reference to the letter cited under reference, I am submitting the following items for discussion in the 10th meeting of Sports and Cultural Board.

- 1) Curtailments of events have already taken place. Games like wrestling, Aquatics, Women's Kabaddi, and Women's Volleyball have been dropped. Only 16 events are there and due to cost cutting only 7 events are being held now. Many things have also been dropped from the All India event. For example, dinner has been dropped. Cost cutting should not lead us to less participation at All India meets. Participation at all India meets should continue as before. All circles should be allowed to participate. Curtailment should be done on the sponsorship of sports events. All circles have Sports recruits and due to the curtailment of sports events for circle level participation, the participation of these sports persons will be hampered at the All India level meets. This will render their very recruitment a waste. If at all curtailment is needed then proper guidelines need to be framed, ensuring due participation for deserving sportsmen.
- 2) Promotions, Increments, Krida awards due for sportsmen have not yet been released. This issue was taken up by us in the last two meetings. We are yet to receive a proper feedback on these issues.
- 3) The Minimum DA for participants of All India Meet had been fixed as Rs 120 in the year 2000 and till today it remains the same. It may be revised to minimum of Rs 500, as the costs have increased manifold. This issue was also taken up in the last two meetings.
- 4) Sports quota persons who have appeared for LICE of telecom mechanic and who have passed the exam and promoted as TM are being left out of the career progression policy for sports men. They may be allowed for promotion as per career progression policy framed for them.

- 5) Expenditure incurred on All India meets, event wise may be circulated. Expenditure incurred on PSU meets, event wise may also be circulated. Similarly expenditure on sports sponsorship may be circulated.
- 6) Kindly also include members of the sports Board as Officials to be nominated as observers, Managers for All India, PSU meets. The members are all sports qualified and their willingness should also be called for. Present circular restricts options only from corporate office.
- 7) Seniority wise list of Technical Delegates may be circulated and as per seniority they should be made Chief referee, Asst chief etc. Transparency should be maintained.
